

## CURVED ACRYLIC TERMINATION ASSEMBLY: ATHLETICA / SPORT SYSTEMS STEPS UP

- Replacing the single glass-termination post at players boxes with a curved acrylic panel attached to an 'energy managing sleeve'
- Upgrading the padding on termination posts
